




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## CCA Mobile (Blended Learning)

CCA Mobile does not change our mission of assisting parents equipping their children to be balanced citizens prepared to impact their homes, churches, and communities for Christ. In this model, we continue to educate the whole child, encourage pursuit of individual passions, promote life balance, and build confidence. CCA Mobile blends daily synchronous (live) instruction with asynchronous (accessible anytime) instruction with a schedule intentionally designed to provide school/life balance, purposefulness, and daily reading.





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## Digital Platforms

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Some teachers and students received a crash course in Google Classroom during the COVID-19 pandemic. This platform will continue to be used by students in all grades. All class assignments, videos, and announcements will be housed in Google Classroom.



Zoom is a video conferencing platform that can be used to provide synchronous virtual class meeting space similar to Google Meet.

Sanitizing and cleaning processes




Institution of capacity limits to allow for social distancing in spaces such as the chapel room, gym, etc.
